

## Committee Report from Sears Student Support Society

There are two different types of fundraising in the school. Sears Student Support Society is the overall school fundraisers. We do not fund raise with hot lunches, the Grade 4 field trip fundraisers or individual grade fundraisers. These are separate from the Society, all monies raised from these events go to support the kids and other aspects of the school (i.e. individual grade field trips, breakfast club, etc.).

The Society's fundraising sponsors 'whole school' items like field trips, in school presentations, busing subsidies for swim/ski lessons, etc.
